⌘ Recipe ⌘

This month we are pleased to present a recipe from Josephine Brogan. Now you can all make the Irish Bread that Josephine brings to ceilis.

Irish Whole Wheat Bread

2 cups of whole wheat Flour
(I use Gold Medal whole wheat Flour)
1 cup of Bran
½ cup of Wheat germ
1 teaspoon of Bread Soda
3 teaspoons of Baking Powder
1 teaspoon of Salt
1 Egg

1 ½ cups Buttermilk approx.

In a large bowl, mix all dry ingredients together until well combined. Add beaten egg mixed in with enough buttermilk to make a soft dough, but firm enough to hold its shape.

Knead on a lightly floured board until dough is smooth. Form into a round loaf and place in a well-buttered, 8-inch cake pan or on a well-buttered cookie sheet. Cut a cross on the top of the loaf with a knife.

Bake in a preheated 375°F. oven for 45 to 50 minutes or until the loaf is nicely browned.
