Dear friends and members,

A short note from me this month, as I'm headed out the door soon for a few weeks in Ireland, on summer holidays. This will be the first trip back there for me since 1998, so a good chance to catch up with college friends who moved back home there to be among family, or to raise their own. In the Comhaltas vein, it will also be the first time I'll have the chance to take in the music and dancing mania of Willie Clancy Festival in Milltown – many of the avid set dancers among us have been before, and highly recommend it, so I suppose my expectations are a bit high, but somehow I doubt I will be disappointed!

As some of you may have heard, there will be a celebration for a special new CD that is being released on July 4<sup>th</sup>, at the festival, that has particular meaning for many of the members of our local Irish music community: The CD comprises the best available recordings of Kevin Keegan, the renowned box player who formed the center of the Irish music scene in San Francisco for many years, and after whom our branch is named. What makes the release of these recordings truly remarkable is that although he was highly regarded as a master musician, he never sought to record albums of his music, and so there has been no easy way until now to hear his style and selection of tunes, for those of us who came to the music more recently.

As I understand it, the new CD has been carefully assembled from a variety of less formal recordings, but should provide a great window on his playing. I plan to pick up at least a few copies, so if you are curious to hear some, let me know...

While I'm away, of course, there will also be great dancing and music workshops here, led by Yutaka Usui and Timmy McCarthy, so don't forget to attend those on the first weekend of July (see inserted flyer). And in the longer term, you'll want to be setting aside the weekend of October 23 and 24<sup>th</sup>, as that will be the date of the first ever West Region mini-convention, hosted right here in S.F. by our branch, and featuring a concert, ceili, workshops, and other activities. So if you haven't been to one of the big North America Comhaltas conventions, this will be a convenient introduction to these events. Event details and schedule should be finalized shortly, but wanted to get the word out about the dates now!
